NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY CONCERNING THE RELATED COMPANIES, L.P. PROJECT LOCATED IN BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS ON TWO PARCELS OF LAND KNOWN AS THE PARCEL 1B AND 1C PROJECT AT LOT 4 AND PARCEL 1B-2 BOUNDED BY CAUSEWAY STREET, BEVERLY STREET, VALENTI WAY AND BUILDINGS ALONG MEDFORD STREET. (the "Partnership" which term includes in this notice any parent, subsidiary, or other affiliate thereof). The proceeds of the bonds will be used to finance and refinance: (i) the construction of an approximately 256,000 square foot rental housing facility to be comprised of approximately 239 residential rental housing units, as well as functionally related and subordinate facilities, including an above grade parking garage containing approximately 220 parking spaces and commercial retail space, all to be initially owned, operated or managed by the Partnership and located in Boston, Massachusetts, on two parcels of land known as the Parcel 1B and 1C Project at Lot 4 and Parcel 1B-2 bounded by Causeway Street, Beverly Street, Valenti Way and buildings along Medford Street; (ii) the acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment for said facility; and (iii) the payment of capitalized interest and costs of issuance (collectively, the "Project"). The total currently estimated cost of the Project is \$127,316,152. The bonds will not constitute a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts or Massachusetts Development Finance Agency.
