

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY CONCERNING THE PROJECT AT 28 WALLINGFORD ROAD, BOSTON (BRIGHTON), MASSACHUSETTS. Notice is hereby given that Massachusetts Development Finance Agency (the “Issuer”) will hold a public hearing on May 11, 2021 at 10:30 A.M. Due to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) and pursuant to the Executive Order of the Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (the “Commonwealth”) regarding the conduct of public hearings in the Commonwealth, the public hearing will be held via the following telephonic conference line in lieu of physical presence at the public hearing:

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider the issuance by the Issuer of qualified 501(c)(3) bonds (the “Bonds”) for a qualified 501(c)(3) project (the “Project”) under the provisions of Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Bonds will be issued in an amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 and used to finance and refinance the Project owned by 2Life Communities Services Inc. (the “Borrower” which term includes in this notice any parent, subsidiary, or other affiliate thereof) generally consisting of: (i) the construction of an approximately 13,000 square foot addition above the Borrower’s existing two-story program center facility located at 28 Wallingford Road, Boston (Brighton), Massachusetts, which addition will be used as office space in connection with the Borrower’s purpose of providing housing and health services to low income seniors; and (ii) the acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment for said facility. The Bonds will not constitute a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of the Commonwealth or the Issuer.
