NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY THE MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY CONCERNING THE FINANCING AND REFINANCING OF A PROJECT FOR THE NORTH EAST EDUCATIONAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL SUPPORTS CENTER, INC. IN PEABODY AND WOBURN, MASSACHUSETTS. Notice is hereby given that the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency (the “Agency”) will hold a public hearing on February 10, 2026, at 11:30 a.m. Persons wishing to participate in the hearing may attend by teleconference by using the toll free telephone number and passcode listed below:

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider the issuance of qualified 501(c)(3) bonds, as defined in Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), by the Agency in an aggregate amount not exceeding \$17,000,000 for a project to be owned and operated by The North East Educational and Developmental Supports Center, Inc. (including for the purposes of this Notice, any parent, subsidiary or other affiliate thereof, the “Borrower”). The proceeds of the bonds will be used to (a) finance and refinance the acquisition, renovation, improvement and equipping of existing facilities located at 247 Lynnfield Street, Peabody, Massachusetts (comprising an approximate 34,000 square foot, one-story building, located on a three acre site), and 240 Salem Street, Woburn, Massachusetts (comprising an approximate 20,000 square foot, one-story building, located on a 3.6 acre site), each to be used to provide day services for individuals with developmental disabilities, and (b) pay costs of issuance.

The bonds will not constitute a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts or the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the project and the proposed issuance of revenue bonds to finance and refinance costs of the project will be given the opportunity to do so at the public hearing.
