NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY CONCERNING A PROJECT LOCATED AT 733 BROADWAY STREET (F/K/A 733-735 BROADWAY STREET), LOWELL, MASSACHUSETTS. Notice is hereby given that Massachusetts Development Finance Agency (the “Issuer”) will hold a public hearing on May 11, 2026 at 9:30 A.M. via the following telephonic conference line in lieu of physical presence at the public hearing:

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider the issuance by the Issuer of exempt facility bonds (the “Bonds”) for a qualified residential rental project under the provisions of Section 142(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, owned by 733 Broadway LLC. The Bonds will be issued in an amount not to exceed \$11,600,000 and used to refund a portion of the outstanding Massachusetts Development Finance Agency Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds, 733 Broadway Issue, Series 2024, the proceeds of which were originally used to finance and refinance: (i) the acquisition of certain land and the existing approximately 23,000 square-foot Merrimack Valley Food Bank building thereon located at 733 Broadway Street (f/k/a 733-735 Broadway Street), Lowell, Massachusetts (the “Property”); (ii) the demolition of a portion of said existing building; (iii) the construction and development of a qualified residential rental project on the Property to consist of a four-story building comprising approximately fifty-two (52) residential rental housing units and functionally related and subordinate facilities, including parking (the “Facility”); and (iv) the acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment for said Facility (collectively, the “Project”). The Bonds will not constitute a general obligation of the Issuer or a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of the Commonwealth.
