

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY CONCERNING A PROJECT LOCATED AT 57 MUNROE STREET, LYNN, MASSACHUSETTS. Notice is hereby given that Massachusetts Development Finance Agency (the “Issuer”) will hold a public hearing on March 10, 2026 at 12:00 P.M. via the following telephonic conference line in lieu of physical presence at the public hearing:

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider the issuance by the Issuer of exempt facility bonds (the “Bonds”) for a qualified residential rental project under the provisions of Section 142(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, owned by Catalyst Housing LLC. The Bonds will be issued in an amount not to exceed \$5,520,000 and used to refund a portion of the outstanding Massachusetts Development Finance Agency Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds, Catalyst Housing Issue, Series 2024, the proceeds of which were originally used to finance and refinance: (i) the acquisition of an interest in certain land and an existing building thereon, located at 57-65 Munroe Street, Lynn, Massachusetts, comprising Unit 2 of the 57-65 Munroe Street Condominium; (ii) the renovation and/or redevelopment of said existing building to consist of a residential rental housing facility comprising approximately twenty-four (24) units and functionally related and subordinate facilities; and (iii) the furnishing and equipping of said rental units and functionally related and subordinate facilities (collectively, the “Project”). The Bonds will not constitute a general obligation of the Issuer or a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of the Commonwealth.

Interested persons wishing to express their views on such Project and the proposed issuance of the Bonds to finance and refinance the Project will be given the opportunity to do so at the
