

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY CONCERNING A PROJECT LOCATED AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATION: 73-87 LAFAYETTE STREET, SALEM, MASSACHUSETTS. Notice is hereby given that Massachusetts Development Finance Agency (the “Issuer”) will hold a public hearing on June 5, 2026 at 1:00 P.M. via the following telephonic conference line in lieu of physical presence at the public hearing:

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider the issuance by the Issuer of qualified 501(c)(3) bonds (the “Bonds”) for a qualified 501(c)(3) project (the “Project”) under the provisions of Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Bonds will be issued in an amount not to exceed \$23,500,000 and used to finance and refinance the Project to be owned by North Shore Community Health, Inc. (the “Borrower” which term includes in this notice any parent, subsidiary, or other affiliate thereof) and generally consisting of: (i) the acquisition of certain land and the existing buildings thereon located at 73-87 Lafayette Street, Salem, Massachusetts; (ii) the demolition of said existing buildings and the construction of an approximately 29,800 square-foot facility at said location (the “Facility”) to serve as the new location of the Salem Family Health Center to be operated by the Borrower, which Facility will also include approximately 2,200 square feet of commercial space; and (iii) the acquisition of furnishings, fixtures and equipment for said Facility. The Bonds will not constitute a general obligation of the Issuer or a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of the Commonwealth.

Interested persons wishing to express their views on such Project and the proposed issuance of the Bonds to finance and refinance the Project will be given the opportunity to do so at the public hearing (via the teleconference line); provided, any persons desiring to speak at the public
