

AMENDED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

This notice amends a notice of the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency (the “Issuer”) posted on its website on March 12, 2020 through March 24, 2020 (the “Original Notice”). This notice replaces in its entirety the Original Notice, but amends the public hearing date and time and further, in order to promote and protect the safety of both the public and the Issuer staff in light of the COVID-19 virus and pursuant to the Executive Order of the Governor of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts (the “Commonwealth”) dated March 12, 2020 regarding the conduct of public hearings in the Commonwealth, provides for a teleconference line for interested persons to utilize in lieu of physical presence at the public hearing.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the Issuer at 11:00 a.m., on Wednesday, April 1, 2020 via the following telephonic conference line:

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider the proposal of The Match Foundation, Inc. (together with its affiliates, the “Borrower”) that the Issuer issue qualified 501(c)(3) bonds (as defined in Section 145 of the Internal Revenue Code), in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$20,369,891.62, to refinance previously issued debt that financed certain educational facilities owned by the Borrower and used by the Borrower and/or Match Charter Public School, a charter public school, and/or another non-profit and/or government entity affiliated with or supported by any of the foregoing, for educational purposes, and located at 50, 100 and 110 Poydras Street in Boston, Massachusetts (the “Site”), or adjacent or proximate sites, including, but not limited to, construction of a new gymnasium building, two new classroom buildings, a surface parking lot, playgrounds and athletic fields.

The bonds proposed to be issued by the Issuer will not constitute a general obligation of the Issuer or a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Interested persons wishing to express their views on the projects and the proposed issuance of qualified 501(c)(3) bonds to refinance the projects will be given the opportunity to do so at the public hearing or may, prior to the time of the public hearing, submit their views in writing to the Issuer at 99 High Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02110.
