

Notice of Public Hearing. MASSACHUSETTS DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AGENCY. Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be conducted by the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency ("MassDevelopment") at 10:00 a.m. on December 14, 2018, at MassDevelopment's offices located at 99 High Street, Boston, Massachusetts, on the proposal of Reading Montessori School, Inc. f/k/a Montessori Children's House of Middlesex, Inc. (the "Borrower") that MassDevelopment (a) approve the following project, including costs of issuance and other costs related thereto: the amendment of the interest rate, maturity date and amortization schedule of MassDevelopment's Section 501(c)(3) Revenue Bonds (Reading Montessori School Project – Series 2007) issued under and pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 23G, in the original principal amount of \$850,000, the proceeds of which were used to finance the renovation of and construction of an addition to an existing building located at 453 West Street, Reading, Massachusetts, for use by the Borrower as a non-profit pre-school, and the purchase of related school equipment; and (b) the deemed reissuance by MassDevelopment, for Federal income tax purposes, of revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$600,000. If MassDevelopment's offices are closed on December 14, 2018 due to unforeseen circumstances, including adverse weather conditions, the public hearing will be held on the next business day on which MassDevelopment's offices are open at the same time and location. Interested individuals shall have the opportunity to express their views, both orally and in writing, on the proposed issuance of the Bonds and the location and nature of the proposed facilities to be financed. The Bonds will not constitute a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of MassDevelopment or The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
